## **Measured Length - Small Vessels Fitted With Outboard Wells/Pods**

Outboard well as an appendage - Outboard wells fitted externally to the "Transom" and "Watertight" to the hull interior shall be considered as an "appendage" unless they provide net positive buoyancy in the swamped condition and have a mean width in excess of half the beam at transom. Appendages are not to be included in measured length. Outboard platforms or extensions fitted externally to the "Transom" shall be considered as an "Appendage" unless they provide "Net Positive Buoyancy" in the swamped condition and have a mean width in excess of half the beam at "Transom".

USL Code specifically excludes "Appendages" from inclusion in measured length.
