Assessment of Navy Sea service

Persons with Navy sea service requiring assessment for civilian marine qualifications are required to provide the following with their application in order to determine eligibility for a certificate of competency:-

1. Personal log of sea service accredited on each vessel whilst at sea;
2. Print out of:
 - Posting profile /PH4/PH14;
 - Applicants length of service and seatime;
 - PH 408 – (if the applicant was a sub lieutenant or commander);
 - Cumulative sea service;:
